

Getting started with Mila + HomeKit

- Open the Mila app on your iPhone.
- Go to the room where your Mila is placed and select it.
- Tap "Add to HomeKit" at the bottom. The app will begin verifying Mila's compatibility with HomeKit.
 - If your Mila needs some additional updates (e.g., a firmware upgrade to make sure you're running the latest and greatest) first before booting up in HomeKit mode, you should see an update screen on your display.
- Once Mila verifies your details, you'll be able to follow the on-screen HomeKit instructions: name your Mila and choose its room.
- Voila! Your Mila is now integrated with HomeKit.

FAQs

1. What does integrating Mila with HomeKit mean?

HomeKit integration allows you to connect and control your Mila devices with Apple's HomeKit platform. This means you can manage your devices using the Home app on your Apple devices or through Siri voice commands.

2. What can I do with Mila and HomeKit?

Once you connect Mila to HomeKit (Apple Home), you can control your Mila devices through the Apple Home app or using Siri. This includes turning devices on or off, adjusting settings, or even setting up automated routines (aka scenes) that trigger based on time, location, or other device states.



3. What secret superpowers should I know about when hooking up Mila with HomeKit?

This connection also unlocks access to six of Mila's sensors (motion, air quality, humidity, temperature, carbon monoxide and carbon dioxide) you can use to create the perfect home environment.

4. Can I use HomeKit and Alexa/Google Assistant at the same time?

Yes, Mila devices can be simultaneously linked to multiple smart home platforms. You can use Alexa, Google Assistant, and HomeKit at the same time, but the exact processes and capabilities might differ between them. Please note Mila is not Matter compatible right now.

Set the scene and let Mila work its magic 🥕

Put your movie director cap on and imagine any moment in your house as a script for your Mila to act out. These automated "scenes" help your Mila playing a starring role in tailoring your household environment to your exact wants and needs. With your guiding specifications, your air purification game might just win an Academy Award. Here's some sample scenes some of you have nominated to get you started.



Increase the Air Flow

Trigger: Mila's Air Quality Sensor notices a spike in your kitchen's AQI. **Action**: Your fan connected to your HomeKit-enabled smart plug turns on to provide some extra circulation, and automatically turns off when air quality settles back to the norm.

How: Create an automation in the Home app based on the Air Quality Sensor's reading. If it increases beyond a certain point, your smart plug (and fan) will turn on.

Movie mode, activated

Trigger: If you have a preset scene like "Movie Time" configured, Mila will work alongside your other smart home devices to help set the stage whenever this mode is activated.

Action: Mila's display will automatically dim and bring fan speeds down, regardless of mode.

How: Add Mila to any existing scenes you might have (such as "Movie Time").

Cat litter, be gone

Trigger: Mila's Motion Sensor notices some movement next to the cat litter.

Action: Your Mila automatically spins up to 70% for 10 minutes before returning to its prior set.

How: Create an automation in the Home app based on the the Motion Sensor. If motion is detected, your Mila's fan will spin up.
